Baptism and Thanksgiving

We're delighted that you're thinking about having a service of **Baptism** or **Thanksgiving** for your child at **St John's Community Church**. Whichever type of service you choose, they are both incredibly special occasions where we join with you in giving thanks to God for the gift of your child, celebrate his love for them, and pray for his blessing to be on them.

Here are some details outlining what the services of **Baptism** and **Thanksgiving** are about, and the differences between the two options:

Baptism for babies and children is often called a Christening. In this service parents thank God for his gift of life, make a decision to start their child on a journey of Christian faith and godparents promise help and support. The church also promises to welcome the child and to pray for the family. For your child, being baptized at a Christening marks the start of a lifelong journey of faith as part of the local and worldwide Christian family.

Alternatively, some parents might want to celebrate the gift of a child with a service of **Thanksgiving**. During this service, parents and families give thanks for the birth or adoption of a child and everyone prays for family life. A Thanksgiving service is not a Baptism - there are no promises to make about the Christian faith - but the child will be blessed and prayed for, and supporting friends and the wider church promise to support the parents in bringing up their child.
