
Sunday 20th October 2024

On Remembrance Sunday we'll be holding a special service outside for our whole community as we come together to remember all who have died and suffer because of war, and pray for peace. We'll be gathering outside church at 10.45am on Sunday 10th November, when we'll be joined by 1st Chase Terrace Scout Group as their band parades from Scout HQ. It's a short but significant service, held outside in place of of our usual 10am Sunday service - all are welcome to attend.

We'll be offering full-immersion baptism as part of our 10am service on Sunday 17th November - a chance to be baptised or to re-affirm baptism vows in our baptistry pool. It's a life-shaping decision and a special experience which is open to all - a unique way for people to publicly declare their faith in Jesus and for us to pray for God's Spirit to be with them in a fresh way. If you haven't been baptised before, or if you've been
