

Enrolling as a member of St John's Community Church is a sign of your commitment to this congregation, and a way of saying that this church has become your 'spiritual home'. St John's Community Church is part of the Church of England, and as a church member, you become part of the 'Electoral Roll' - a legal list of members who are eligible to attend the Annual Parochial Church Meeting (APCM), vote on church matters, and, after being on the Electoral Roll for six months, stand for election to the Parochial Church Council (PCC) or Deanery Synod. As a church member, you will be encouraged to play your part in helping to shape the mission and ministry of St John's.

Anyone can become a member of St John's Community Church, although in order to be included on the Electoral Roll, you will also need to have been baptised, be aged 16 or over, and either live in the parish or have worshipped at St John's for six months prior to enrolment. BOX A

Electoral Roll: In order to keep the Electoral Roll relatively up to date, a new list is prepared every 6 years. The next date for this 'reset' will be in 2031, when all existing members will be asked to fill in a new form should they wish to continue as members of St John's Community Church.

Data Protection: Any personal information you give will be processed in accordance with **General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR)**.

The details on this form will be stored in a computer database with restricted access, & will be used as part of normal church management. However, under GDPR, you now need to **give your consent** for us to use your details to contact you - a tick box is therefore included on the form.

Church Directory: We also produce a Church Directory - a <u>paper-only</u> listing of members' names, address & contact numbers which is available to all members of the church, & is a useful way for church folks to be able to stay in touch with each other. However, again under GDPR, you will need to give your consent in order for us to be able to include your details - a second tick box is therefore included on the form.
