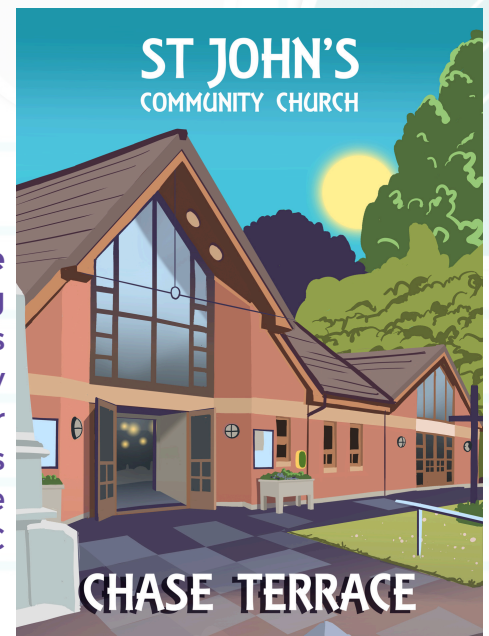


Sunday 11th January 2026
