


Sunday 15th March 2026

A very warm welcome to St John's Community Church. Whether this is your first time with us, or you've been part of our church for some time, it's great to see you...



In our 10am service this morning, **Laura is leading** and **Ian is speaking** as we continue our Sunday series 'Journey To Jerusalem', in which we're exploring some of the events that led to Jesus' crucifixion and

what these might have to teach us about our faith today. Alongside sung worship and prayer, we've got our **Shooting Stars, Super Stars** and **The Mess** groups for children and young people, and do stick around after the service to chat and catch up over refreshments too.



With **Easter** coming up, here are the details of a number of **special services** taking place at St




John's during what's known as 'Holy Week', as we reflect on and celebrate the significance of Jesus' final journey to the cross, his crucifixion and his resurrection. **10am Palm Sunday 29th March** - Our 10am Sunday service, with time to worship in song, time to pray, an opportunity to consider the story of Jesus' entry into Jerusalem, and our Sunday Stars and The Mess groups for young people.

7pm Maundy Thursday 2nd April - A gentle, reflective evening service with Communion, as we recall the events and meaning of Jesus' Last Supper on the night before he died.



2pm Good Friday 3rd April - 'An Hour At The Cross'. This is our meditative service on Good Friday afternoon, using led reflections, silence and music to engage with the significance of Jesus' death on the cross.

10am Easter Sunday 5th April - Our Easter Sunday morning resurrection celebration! With worship led by the band, prayers, time to reflect on the wonder of Jesus' resurrection, the invitation to share in **Communion**, alongside children's and young people's activities. We'll



also be enjoying some **baptisms**, both at the font and by full immersion in our baptistry pool. It's a special experience which is open to all - a unique way for people to publicly declare their faith in Jesus and for us to pray for God's Spirit to be with them. If you'd like to be baptised, or if you've been baptised in your younger years and would like to reaffirm the promises made on your behalf, **please see Matt, Laura or Marie**.



Creating Space is back in a couple of weeks time at **10am on Saturday 28th March**, this time for a morning of **Poetry Writing**. 

We'll be holding our **Annual Parochial Church Meeting (APCM)** during our **10am service on Sunday 19th April**. It'll be an opportunity to look back over our past year as a church, to hear reports on our finances, and to consider what might lie ahead for us with God. We'll also be **electing church wardens and representatives to our PCC** - the 'Parochial Church Council' who are the Trustees of St John's. All are welcome to attend the APCM and the service as a whole, although only those on the church electoral roll (the official church membership scheme we have) can stand for the PCC or vote for PCC members. If you've been coming to St John's for a little while, and you'd like to **join the electoral roll**, do simply **fill out a form** which can be found in the foyer or on the [church website](#) under the '[About-Forms](#)' tab. We currently have around **200 people on our electoral roll**, so you'll be in good company, and it's a big help in enabling us to keep in touch with you over the course of the year. 
