


Palm Sunday 29th March 2026

A very warm welcome to St John's Community Church. Whether this is your first time with us, or you've been part of our church for some time, it's great to see you...






As **Holy Week** unfolds, **Matt** is leading our **Monday 10am service** on **Monday 30th March**, in which there'll be time to reflect, pray and share Communion. At **7pm** on **Thursday 2nd April**, **Linda** will be leading our **Maundy Thursday** service - a chance to gather and share as we remember Jesus' Last



Supper through prayer, music, reflection, worship, bread and wine. The following afternoon at **2pm** on **Good Friday 3rd April**, **Laura** is leading us through 'An Hour At The Cross' - a gentle and meditative service of led reflections, silence and music to engage with the experience and significance of Jesus' death on the cross and all that it means for us today.



On **Easter Sunday 5th April**, for early-birds, there's the offer to join with other folks from local churches for an **Easter sunrise service** at **Castle Ring** at **6am**... And then at **10am** on **Easter Sunday**, we're celebrating **Jesus' resurrection** here at St John's with our **Easter Sunday service!** **Matt's** leading us through, with worship led by the band, prayers, time to reflect on the wonder of Jesus' resurrection, the offer of Communion, and activities for children and young people. We'll also be enjoying some **baptisms**, both at the font and in our baptistry pool, as **Elicia**, **Heidi** and **Claudia** are baptised or renew their baptism vows. **If you'd like to join them in being baptised**, there's still time, so do please have a chat with **Matt** or **Laura** if so. As always, all are welcome on Easter Sunday as we celebrate Jesus' resurrection and his promise of new life for us all!





We'll be holding our **Annual Parochial Church Meeting (APCM)** during our **10am service on Sunday 19th April**. It'll be an opportunity to look back over our past year as a church, to hear reports on our finances, and to consider what might lie ahead for us with God. We'll also be **electing church wardens and representatives to our PCC** - the 'Parochial Church Council' who are the Trustees of St John's. All are welcome to

attend the APCM and the service as a whole, although only those on the church electoral roll (the official church membership scheme we have) can stand for the PCC or vote for PCC members. If you've been coming to St John's for a little while, and you'd like to **join the electoral roll**, do simply **fill out a form** which can be found in the foyer or on the [church website](#) under the '[About-Forms](#)' tab. We currently have around **200 people on our electoral roll**, so you'll be in good company! If you'd like to **stand for election to the PCC** (or Deanery Synod, with elections also taking place this year), nomination forms are available from the church office - do have a chat with **Matt, Laura, Nigel or Marg** to find out more. Thank you.



Giving financially is a key way in which we express our worship to God and our commitment to our church community. St John's Community Church is a **registered charity** (1131458), and we rely on people's giving to enable us to do everything that we do. All church members are encouraged to **give as part of their worship**, and all gifts, whether large

or small, regular or infrequent, are **much appreciated and carefully managed** by the PCC. However, if you think of St John's as your church, **do please consider starting or raising your regular giving**, as having a regular income is really helpful for us as a church in setting our budget for future plans and activities. We don't take a collection during the service, but many folks give regularly by standing order. Others give cash, or use our contactless giving unit in the foyer. You can also give to St John's through this QR code. As a registered charity, we can reclaim tax on donations through the **gift aid** scheme. If you're a taxpayer, all of your giving can be boosted by an extra 20% (at no cost to you). **Do please therefore register for free by filling in a gift aid form**, available in the foyer or from the 'About-Forms' page on our [church website](#) and return that to **Marie** in the church office - thank you very much. 
