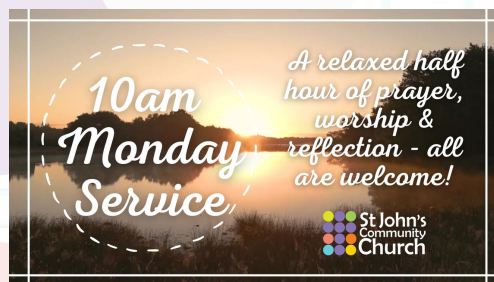

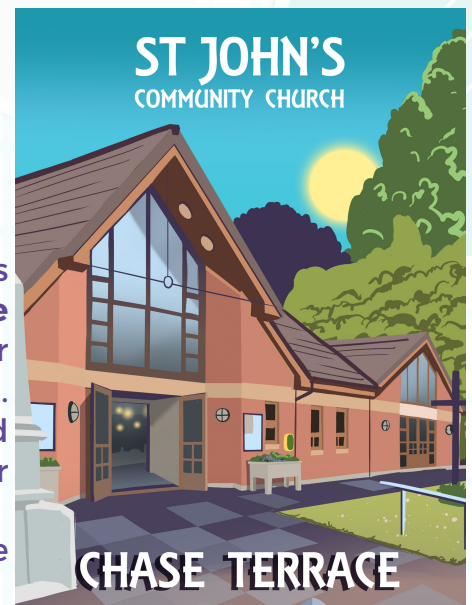
A very warm welcome to St John's Community Church. Whether this is your first time with us, or you've been part of our church for some time, it's great to see you...



In our 10am service this morning, **Ian** is leading and **Dave** is speaking as we continue our 'Everyday People' series. Alongside **sung worship** and time to **pray**, we've got our **Sunday Stars** and **The Mess** groups for children and young people, and the **prayer team** are available too. Do stay on for **refreshments** if you can as well.



On Monday mornings, we hold our **10am Monday service** - a gentle and relaxed half hour of prayer, music and reflection, to which all are welcome! This **Monday 3rd August**, **John Nicholls** will be



leading our service, and it'd be great to see you. A good number of folks then stay on for or come along to our **Drop Inn** café from **10.30am-12pm** - a morning of hot and cold drinks, scrumptious cakes and friendly chat! **Talking Point** is also on offer during this time, when **Kathy Coe** is available to quietly chat with anyone experiencing or concerned about domestic or sexual abuse. Our 10am service and The Drop Inn take place each Monday except for bank holidays (e.g. **Bank Holiday Monday 31st August**), and many make it part of their weekly routine. If you fancy **joining the Drop Inn team** in helping to serve, wash up and generally offer a warm welcome, you'd be most welcome - please see **Jan Moss**. Most folks help once a month or so, and we can gladly rota you on! Equally, if you're a baker and could **bake a cake**, or **supply a bought one** once a month or so, that'd be great - again, please see Jan. **Thank you!**



Being With is a new **10-week course** that we'll be running at **10am-12pm** on Tuesday mornings, starting on **Tuesday 29th September**. It's a chance to **explore the Christian faith** and its relevance to our lives now - but it's not your typical course! It's a space for anyone who's curious about faith, exploring Christianity, or maybe just wondering where they stand with it all. You might be returning to faith after some time away, asking whether what you once believed still holds

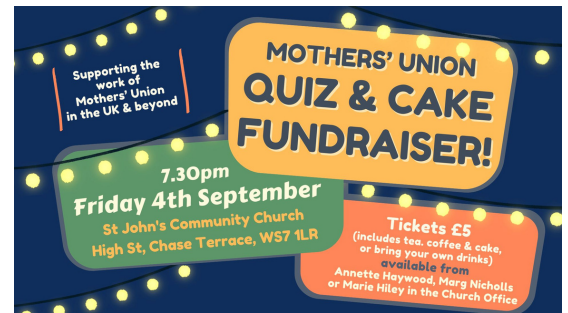
true, or maybe you've had experiences of church that left you unsure. Being With offers something gentler - a place where you can listen, share and reflect alongside others, with no pressure and no judgement. No special knowledge needed - just what you have learned in life so far! 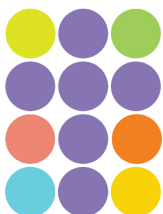
